Past awardees have included honor graduates of the W. Deen Mohammed High School in Atlanta, Georgia. This year's applicants must be enrolled in or accepted by a full-time undergraduate (12 or more credit hours), graduate (9 or more credit hours), or professional program at an accredited university in the United States. Students awaiting acceptance notice from a University must receive acceptance not later than June 15, 2012. Final selection criteria include a weighted preference for current enrollment at or graduation from a secondary school in association with the leadership of Imam W. Deen Mohammed.
